# REQUIREMENTS FOR THE IMPORTATION OF BIOLOGICAL CONTROL ORGANISMS FROM THIRD COUNTRIES

To import biological control organisms, the following conditions must be met:

- They must be accompanied by a commercial document.
- The importer (IMP-171) must sign a declaration stating that the use of the imported products is exclusively for biological control purposes.

## 1. Authorized country

They may come from any country.

# 2. Commercial Document

The following information must appear on the Commercial Document:

- Name and address of the consignor and consignee;
- Name and address of the destination establishment;
- Country of origin;
- Control Entity (Animal species);
- Register number that appears on the MAPA web page.
- Commercial name

## 3. Importer's declaration

The importer shall sign a declaration in accordance with the model of this instruction (IMP-171).

#### **EXPLAINATORY NOTES:**

- 1.-Bumblebees of genus **Bombus spp** are excluded from this procedure, since their import requirements are established in Regulation (EU) no 206/2010, of the Commission, of 12<sup>th</sup> march.
- 2.- Any non-viable eggs or ooquists of insects or crustaceans intended for feeding other insects are also excluded from this procedure.
