



## **REQUIREMENTS FOR THE IMPORTATION OF INSECT EGGS OR NON-VIABLE CRUSTACEAN CYSTS FOR INSECT FEEDING FROM THIRD COUNTRIES**

To import insect eggs or non-viable crustacean cysts intended for insect feeding, the following conditions must be met:

- They are accompanied by a commercial document.
- The importer signs a declaration ensuring that the destination of the imported products is exclusively their use for insect feeding.

### 1. Authorised country

They may come from any country.

### 2. Commercial Document

The commercial document must contain the following information:

- Name and address of consignor and consignee.
- Establishment of destination.
- Country of origin.
- Animal species.
- The product has received sufficient treatment to ensure that the eggs or cysts are not alive and have lost all reproductive ability.

### 3. Importer declaration

The importer shall sign a declaration in accordance with the model of this instruction (IMP-167).

### 4.- Registration of the importer.

The importer must be registered as an importer of feed materials.
