ETHICS AND GOOD PRACTICE

Publication and authorship:

- The author(s) formally state that the papers are not plagiarised, they have not been submitted to other publications, they are not being reviewed by other publications and they contain no fraudulent data.
- The papers shall contain a section to include references of the research cited in the text. The reference details shall be taken from the source document to which it refers, principally the cover, and where necessary from other parts of the research.
- For articles where there is financial support, reference should be made to such financial support and its relationship to the author(s).

Author's responsibilities:

- The author(s) undertake to take into account the observations and corrections made throughout the review process.
- Once the article has been published, the authors are obliged to correct any mistakes, being able to
 respond to the criticisms received and to publish them, if the editor deems this to be necessary.
- Furthermore, they should indicate that all authors have significantly contributed to the compilation of the paper and that such paper contains no fraudulent data.

Peer review / responsibility for the reviewers:

- They should be objective in their judgements, indicating, where appropriate, any deficiencies in the citations of the paper.
- Reviewers should have no conflict of interest with respect to the authors, the research or the research funder, where applicable.
- Reviewers should treat the reviewed articles confidentially.

Editorial responsibilities:

- To assure the quality of *Revista Española de Estudios Agrosociales y Pesqueros*, a rigorous process is followed in the selection and review of the original articles submitted.
- The editorial board shall only accept papers with reasonably original content, to be subsequently anonymously reviewed by two reviewers of proven scientific expertise, their identity being anonymous.
- Acceptance or rejection of original articles ultimately lies with the editorial board. Furthermore, its members should have no conflict of interest with respect to rejected or accepted articles.
- Where errors in the article are found, the editorial board shall promote the publication of corrections.
- The authors are solely liable for the opinions issued in the articles published by *Revista Española de Estudios Agrosociales y Pesqueros*.

Publishing ethics issues:

- The Ministry of Agriculture, Fish and Food, as publisher, shall oversee compliance with the ethics stipulated by the editorial board.
- No business shall be entered into that compromises intellectual and ethical standards.
- Corrections, clarifications, retractions and apologies shall be published when needed.
