Reference is made to notification [2024-025](#), dated 8 March 2024, regarding the informal discussions on digital sequence information (DSI) on genetic resources, which will be held on 19 May 2024 in Nairobi, Kenya. As indicated in the above-mentioned notification, this workshop will provide updates on the intersessional work on DSI, including informal activities and studies under development.

The morning session's agenda will consist of updates on the co-chairs' intersessional activities, including the work of the Ad Hoc Open-ended Informal Advisory Group on Benefit-sharing from the Use of DSI; presentations on other informal activities on DSI not linked to the Secretariat, and a presentation on the studies commissioned pursuant to decision 15/9, paragraph 22 (b) and (c), including the peer-review process for those studies. The afternoon session will consist of informal discussions and exchanges and include an overview of the formal process that will lead to the second meeting of the Working Group on Benefit-sharing from the Use of DSI, and to the sixteenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties.
