Invitation to participate in the Survey on establishing linkages between the Biosafety Clearing-House and national websites

Dear Sir or Madam,

As you are aware, in decision <u>CP-10/5</u>, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Cartagena Protocol requested the Executive Secretary to explore how the Bioland tool, which is currently available to Governments that wish to build a national clearing-house website, could be used to facilitate the linkage between national websites and the Biosafety Clearing-House (BCH), and other mechanisms that allow national clearing-houses to retrieve information from the BCH.

At its twelfth meeting, held in Montreal, Canada on 15-16 May 2023, the Informal Advisory Committee on the BCH (BCH-IAC) made several recommendations to the Secretariat, including a process to phase-out the use of the Hermes website tool as a national BCH application (Annex, paragraph b of the report). The report of the twelfth meeting of the BCH-IAC is available here.

Pursuant to the above recommendation, the Secretariat has prepared a survey to assess the experience of users with the existing BCH national website tools and explore the expectations for the future, with the aim to understand better countries' needs for their national websites.

I therefore invite all focal points to the Cartagena Protocol to respond to the survey at their earliest convenience, but no later than **23 February 2024**.
